MAINTAINING BATTERY CHARGE

APPLIED VEHICLE(S): All Models

SERVICE INFORMATION

The following maintenance procedures should be used to insure that the battery has a good level of charge when the vehicle is delivered to the customer.

- Storage Fuse -- When the storage fuse is installed, components such as the radio, digital clock, etc. draw current from the battery (even with the ignition "off"). Therefore, vehicles should <u>not</u> be stored with the storage fuse installed. This fuse should be installed just before vehicle delivery to the customer.
- 2. Interior/Accessory Lights -- All interior, map lamp, and accessory light switches should be in the "off" position while the vehicle is in storage.
- 3. **Ignition Key** -- The key should be removed from the ignition switch during storage.
- 4. **Doors/Hood/Trunk--** All doors, hood and trunk should be securely closed while vehicle is in storage.
- 5. **Battery Charging** -- Check battery periodically while vehicle is in dealer inventory, and recharge according to the charging procedure specified in the Service Manual if necessary.
